Dear colleagues, mayors of the World Heritage Cities,

on the occasion of the inscription of the Historical Town of Banská Štiavnica and Technical Monuments in its Vicinity on the UNESCO World Heritage List, our municipality started to organise a youthful creativity event.

Following the success of the contest for grade school students that marked the 24th anniversary, we have decided to hold **the 25th edition of the contest**. School children are invited to participate by using their creativity to represent either their own World Heritage City or any World Heritage City or Site around the globe. To participate, the following conditions should be met:

- ❑ entries should be submitted in one of three categories – **ages up to 9, 10 – 12 and 13 – 15**;
- ❑ drawings, paintings, water colours, monotypes, linocuts, intarsia, collages and the like should be submitted in standard **10 x 14 cm postcard format mailed preferably in an envelope** (for the entire school) and marked with the catchword "Vision 2019";
- ❑ artwork should completely cover the front of the postcard with the back reserved for the **full name of the participant, his/her age and complete return address of the school** (in block letters in Roman alphabet);
- ❑ history, impressions, artefacts, daily life, inhabitants, even the future, are **all themes** that are suggested to inspire the creative efforts of all participants;
- ❑ individual students may submit **as many as three** different entries which are expected to be received not later than **30th April 2019** to the address:

In June 2019, based on the entries received, we will inaugurate an exhibit entitled
"World Heritage – A Youthful Vision 2019"

during which three of the best entries in each category will be awarded. After Banská Štiavnica, the exhibit will then travel throughout the OWHC network. In case of your interest to reopen the exhibit also in your city, please send us the name of the responsible person we may contact in order to agree details (place, date and the like) before 30th April 2019.

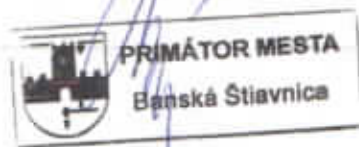
Only entries from schools located in the World Heritage cities will be accepted.

CONSENT TO PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

Information About Your Personal Data Processing

Purpose of personal data processing: participation in the international drawing contest "World Heritage – A Youthful Vision 2019" and result presentations in media

Legal basis for the personal data processing: consent to personal data processing following Article 6, par. 1, letter a) of the Regulation

Recipients: schools and cities participating in the contest, Organisation of the World Heritage Cities

Categories of personal data: name, surname, age of a child, school, city, country

Retention period of personal data: the consent is valid for duration of the contest and 3 years after the announcement of the contest's results

Automated decision making including profiling is not effectuated.

Rights of the Subject:

Right to withdraw the consent:

- in cases when your personal data are processed according to your consent, you have the right to withdraw the consent anytime. The consent can be withdrawn in electronic form sending it to the address of the person responsible, in writing by notice of withdrawal of the consent or in person at the seat of the Controller. The withdrawal of the consent does not affect the lawfulness of personal data processing we have processed according to your consent.

Right of access:

- you have right to be provided by a copy of personal data we have about you as well as information how we use your personal data. In most cases your personal data will be provided to you in written form if you do not require other way of providing. If you have requested to provide the information by electronic means they will be provided to you in electronic form if it is technically possible.

Right of rectification:

- we take measures to ensure accuracy, completeness and timeliness of information kept about you. If you think your personal data we have at our disposal are inaccurate, incomplete or not current do not hesitate to ask us to rectify, update or complete them.

Right to erasure (right to be forgotten):

- you have the right to request erasing your personal data, for example in cases when personal data we have received about you are not longer necessary to fulfil the original purpose of processing. However, your right has to be evaluated from the point of view of all relevant circumstances. For example, you may have some legal or regulatory obligations therefore, we will not be able to meet your request.

Right to restriction of processing:

- in certain circumstances you are entitled to ask us not to use your personal data. For example in cases you think the personal data that are at our disposal may be inaccurate or when you think we do not need to use your personal data anymore.

Right to data portability:

- in certain circumstances you are entitled to ask us to transfer personal data you have provided us to a third party of your choice. Right to portability is related only to those personal data we have received under your consent or agreement of which you are of the parties.

Right to object:

- you have the right to object to your personal data processing based on our legitimate interests. In case we do not have conclusive legitimate reason to personal data processing and you object we will not process your personal data anymore.

Right to file a claim for the opening of the proceedings for personal data protection:

- in you believe your personal data are being processed unfairly or illegally you may file a complaint with the Office for Personal Data Protection of the Slovak Republic, Hraničná 12, 820 07 Bratislava 27, Slovakia, tel. number: +421 2 3231 3214, e-mail: statny.dozor@pdp.gov.sk, dataprotection.gov.sk. In case of submitting a claim in electronic form it should fulfil requirements under § 19, par 1 of Act no. 71/1961 Coll. on Administrative Procedure.
